






# REASONS ARCHIVE COLLECTIONS ARE MISSING RESOURCES FOR UNDERREPRESENTED GROUPS.

Collection priorities were not focused on these groups.

These groups can have a distrust of government run institutions that have ignored, failed, or even persecuted them before.

Cultural differences cause archivists to be hesitant to reach out into these communities.

Photocopy relevant periodicals such as newspapers relating to the community.






And now the hard part...
